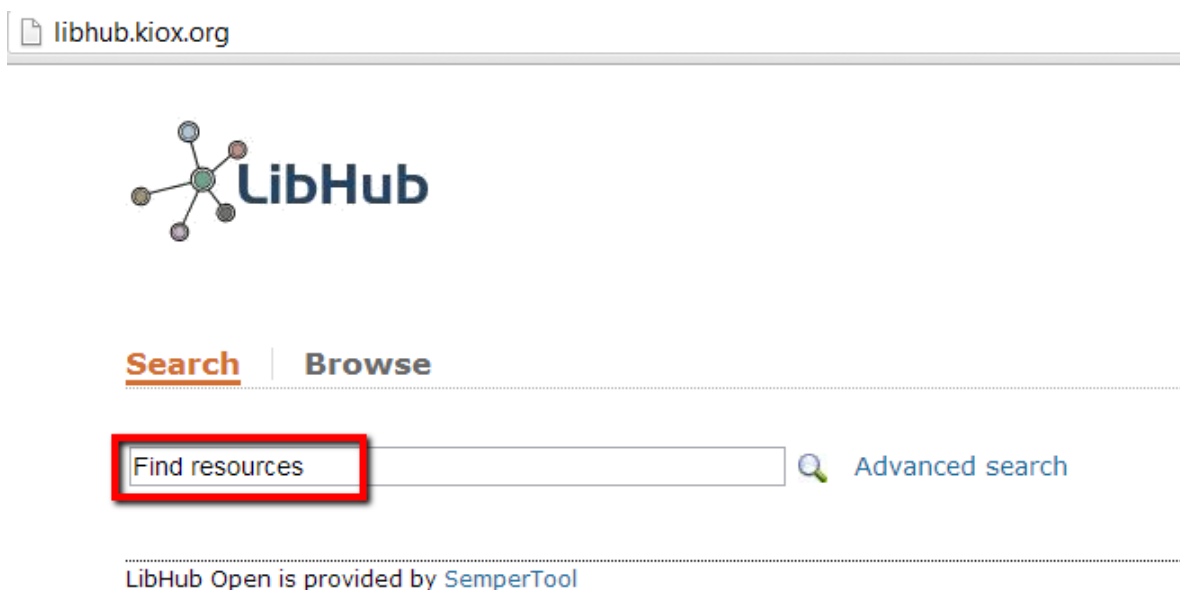
Electronic resources are a very important tool in academic work. Carlile College subscribes to a number of online databases. The instructions below will direct you on finding resources within these databases, focusing primarily on academic journal articles.

How to Find Electronic Resources

1. Search using <http://libhub.kiox.org/>. You can either type this directly into your address bar or follow the 'E-resources' link from the Carlile College webpage (pictured below).



Once you have reached <http://libhub.kiox.org/>, it will look like this.



Search for the topic you are interested in. An example search, for 'Uganda religion', is pictured below:

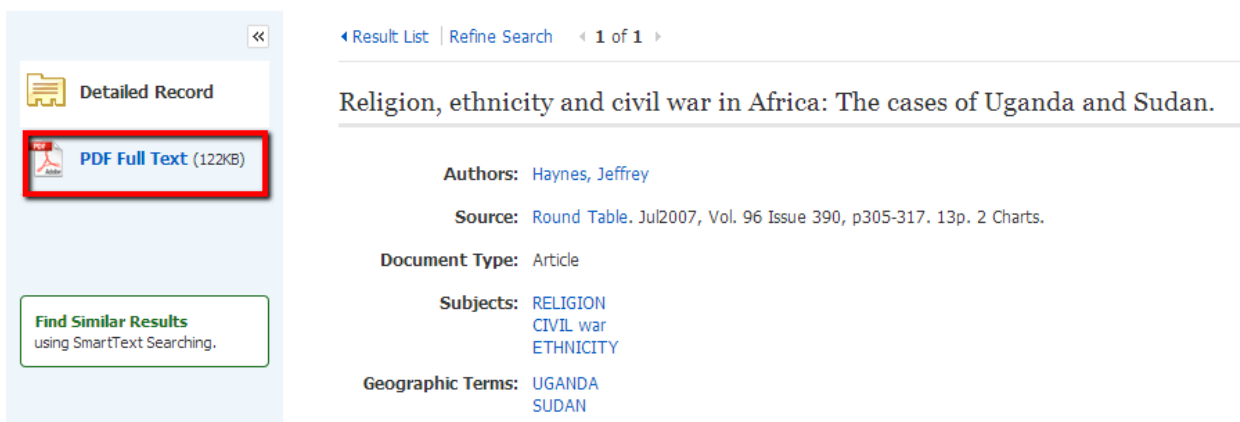
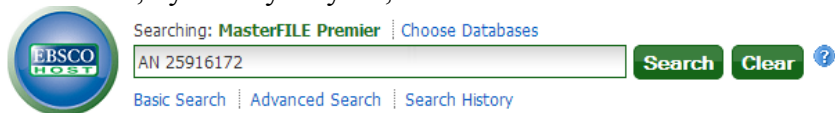

Religion, Ethnicity and Civil War in Africa: The Cases of Uganda and Sudan

ABSTRACT *This paper focuses upon two former British colonies—Uganda and Sudan—to illustrate the contention that civil wars in Africa are typically rooted in religio-ethnic competition and conflict. Such conflicts are normally exacerbated by group competition for material resources in circumstances of developmental failures and political instability. To attempt to deal with the problems that cause religious and ethnic conflict leading to civil war, it is necessary for African countries, including Uganda and Sudan, meaningfully to democratise – to the extent that the great majority of citizens feel that they have a stake in their country’s political future. The chances of such an outcome are improved when economies show signs of growing over time and when governments manage to disseminate developmental gains relatively equitably.*



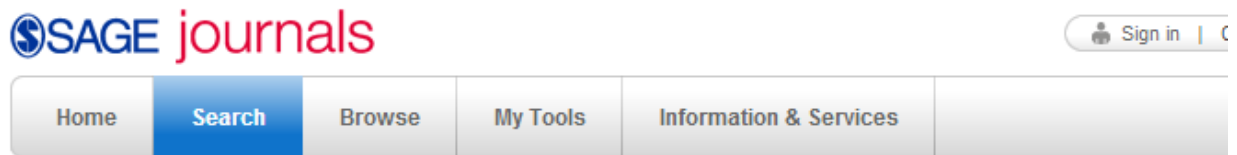

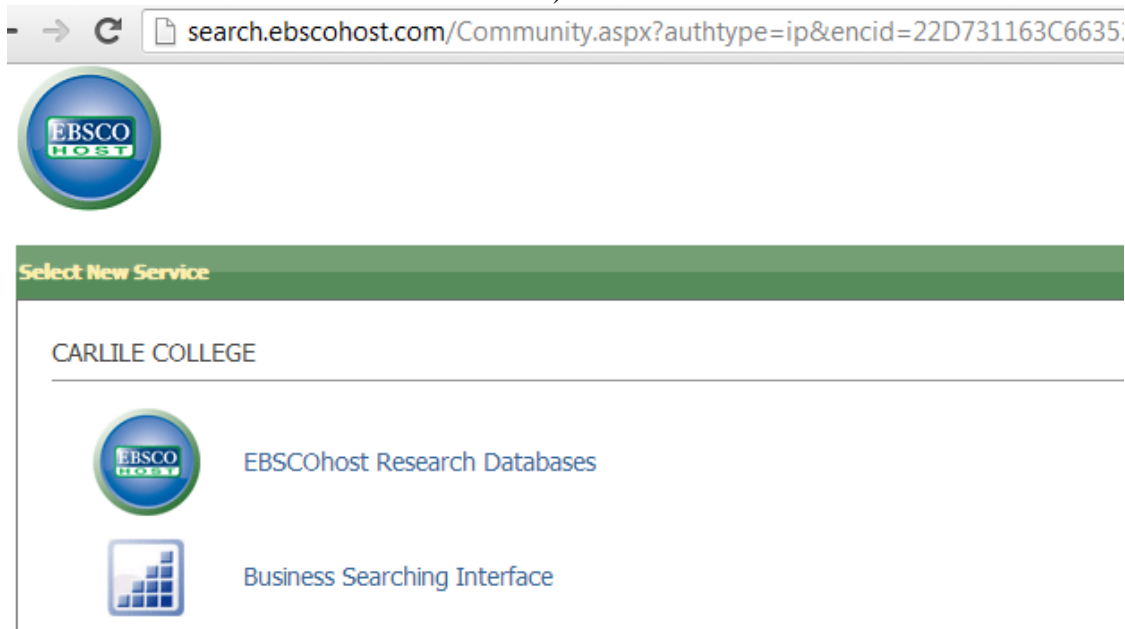

3.1. To search EBSCO, you must first select the databases. For best results, select Academic Search Premier, the ATLA Religion Database with ATLASerials, and the Religion and Philosophy Collection. Those three are pictured on the next page.

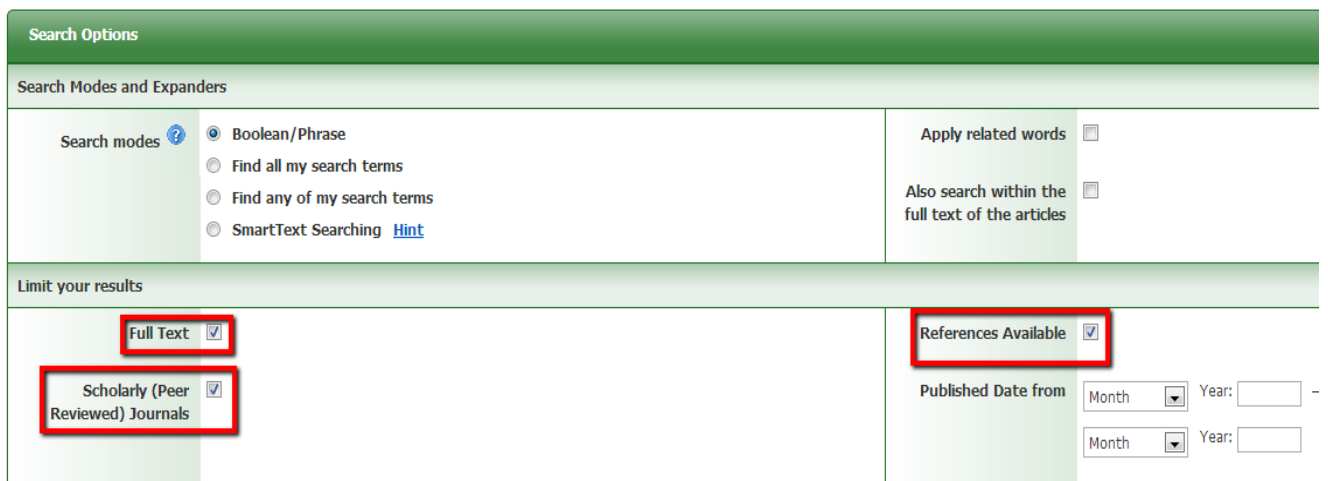
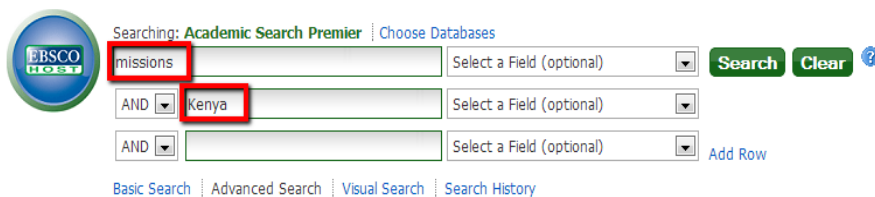
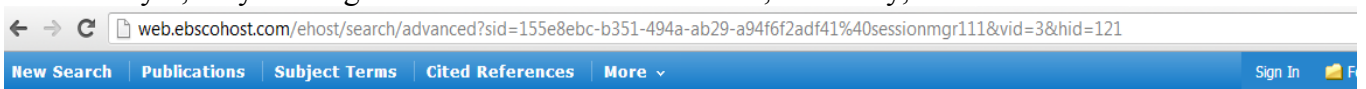

Find the most recent good (serious-looking and focused) article/essay/book and browse the footnotes and bibliographies for additional articles.

Tips for Searching

- Try to be as specific as possible with your search terms (add “AND” all caps between terms to make sure all terms appear.)
- If you get too many results, try limiting search term to “title” and “abstract” only in advance search (especially for SAGE and JSTOR.)
- If you aren’t getting enough results use broader search terms or “OR” between words.
- If you are looking for articles on a specific Bible passage, use quotation marks around the entire passage. E.g. “Acts 1:6” otherwise, it will search on every single word/number and you will get thousands of results. (Do different combinations.)
- To narrow your search to articles downloadable from EBSCO, limit your results: Check boxes “*Full Text*” and always “*Scholarly (Peer Reviewed) Journals*” for academic work.
- Save the PDFs onto your hard drive, so you can come back to them off line.
