- Minimum C- in K.C.S.E (Students who have no C- and above will be admitted into a one year certificate in Christian Ministry, on completion (with an average pass of 50% and above) they can then enroll for any of the diploma courses at Carlile College.
- Application Fee of Kshs. 200/=
- Recommendation from your Bishop or the Senior Clergy in your church.

### ACCOMMODATION

Accommodated students in DCMCR, Chaplaincy and DCFM programs pay an additional Kshs. 1,500 to cater for any medical emergency and a refundable caution fee of Kshs. 5,000/=.

## OUR PROGRAMMES

### DIPLOMA IN CHAPLAINCY – DCMSC

The Diploma in Christian Ministries – School Chaplaincy is a programme for school teachers and youth workers. It provides training in Pastoral Care, Discipleship and Evangelism in the context of primary and secondary schools.

Mode of Study: School based,  
2 weeks intensive in April,  
August & December for two years

### DIPLOMA IN CHILDREN AND FAMILY MINISTRY - DCFM

This programme equips those involved in Children's ministries, and those who minister to families with a strong foundation in evangelism and discipleship for the transformation of the children & families of Africa. The programme runs for 2 years and comprises of 72 credit hours using the Intensives and Distance Learning Model (2 weeks intensive twice per year in May and November.



Distance learning requires students to submit all work in soft copy via email, and to send and receive assignments weekly through the months between intensives.



\*Use of a computer and weekly email access is a programme requirement.  
\* Fees Kshs. **29,667/=** per semester.

*Certificate in Christian Ministry\* (For those who do not meet the minimum entry requirement of C- and above)*

### DIPLOMA IN CHRISTIAN MISSION AND CIVIC RESPONSIBILITIES – DCMCR

The programme targets Lay Ministers of the Church, and Community Leaders. They are equipped with knowledge in Civic and Religious matters from a Christian mission perspective. They then become more effective agents of transformation in their communities.

\*Fees Kshs. **26,250/=** per Semester\*.

### DIPLOMA IN CHRISTIAN MISSION (DCM)

This is a diploma in both Cross-cultural and Urban Mission. Cross-cultural mission courses train ministers of the church for God's work in cross-cultural contexts while urban mission trains ministers in God's work specifically for ministry in urban contexts among the marginalized i.e. the poor economically, and socially.

#### Mode of study.

This is a two-year program run in three semesters in a year. Classes happen at Carlile and Kibera (Tafakari Centre) for the urban option courses.
